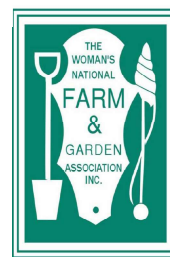

Seed Sources:

Local Libraries – Several libraries (for instance, **Upper Dublin and Horsham**) have community Seed Catalogs, where you can get FREE seeds. Ambler Keystone Farm & Garden contributes native seeds to the Upper Dublin Library each year. When planting native seeds, remember that they often need to overwinter (cold stratification) in damp soil to germinate properly. The method of winter sowing in milk jugs is often used to germinate native seeds. Alternatively, you can simply scatter seeds in the fall and see what pops up in spring.
